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## RETURNING VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION

## **SHIFT REQUEST PROCESS**

We have implemented an online scheduling process to better suit the needs of our volunteers. But in order to allow everyone to do their minimum of 42 hours, preference will be given to those who can be the most flexible so we have the required number of people on at all times. RETURNING VOLUNTEERS, PLEASE NOTE: This year's Volunteer Pin Ceremony will take place on Friday August 12th at 9:30am. If you are a 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, or 30-year volunteer, please do not select a shift for this time, so you can attend the ceremony. Formal invitations will be distributed at the volunteer package pickups. Please note that if you worked in 2021 and hit one of the milestone volunteer years mentioned above, you will be receiving your pin this year.
